

Lets explore..

From the Coast to the Highlands

Start your journey in Bowral at the new International Cricket Hall of Fame. Travelling 5 min west of Bowral visit the picturesque Centennial Vineyards then follow the road to the historic village of Berrima. Head back along Berrima Rd towards Moss Vale and along the Illawarra Hwy towards Robertson or visit the village of Burrawang. Follow the Illawarra Hwy to the famous Robertson Pie shop and then right down Jamberoo Mountain Road to the Illawarra Fly. Complete your journey down Jamberoo Mountain Road back to the coast.

Canberra to the Coast

Take the Sutton Forest exit from the Hume Hwy into the village of Sutton Forest and visit the famous gardens of Red Cow Farm. Nearby is the historic Montrose Berry Farm. Follow the Illawarra Highway to Robertson, along your journey you will see signs for Exeter Village, Mount Ashby Winery or Burrawang Village. Head through Robertson towards the Robertson Pie shop and turn right down Jamberoo Mountain Rd to the Illawarra Fly. Continue down the mountain to Kiama and the blowhole and stay overnight or head back to Canberra.

Sydney to the Illawarra Fly

One hour south of Sydney from the Royal National Park is the Grand Pacific Drive taking you through the rainforest and coastal seaside towns of Thirroul and Austinmer down to Shoalhaven. Visit Wollongong Harbour, Five Islands Brewery and Nan Tein Temple. Continuing south along the Hwy to Albion Park, turn right onto the Illawarra Hwy and follow the signs to the Illawarra Fly. Continue back down Jamberoo Mountain Rd to Kiama to see the blowhole and back to Sydney popping into the visitor information centre and café in the Southern Gateway at Bulli Tops. Alternatively take the expressway to Bowral and through the villages of the Southern Highlands onto the Hume Highway and M5.

From the Southern Highlands to Illawarra Fly

Take the Nowra Road to Fitzroy Falls a spectacular waterfall and native bushland. Continue down the mountain to Kangaroo Valley, a pretty village with rivers and creeks, pubs, cafes, canoeing and bushwalks. Follow the coastal road to Kiama marveling at the beauty of some of the South coast's best beaches. Experience the thrill of the Kiama blowhole and up the mountain to the Illawarra Fly. Your journey ends at the village of Robertson back through the Highlands. Why not stop at the Burrawang Pub for a cleansing ale or crisp wine and enjoy the picturesque views from the Beer Garden on your journey home.

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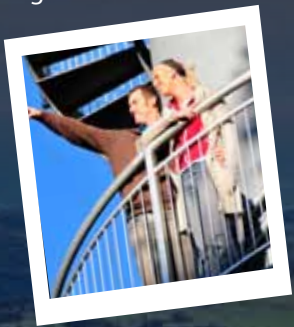

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Illawarra Fly Treetop Walk

The Illawarra Fly Treetop Walk is a unique rainforest experience, where you walk through the beautiful warm temperate rainforest at 25 metres above the ground.



Set atop the escarpment of Knight's Hill, the 500 metre walkway features two cantilevered arms, that sway and take visitors to the edge of the forest that will excite both young and old.

Knights Tower stands at an exhilarating height of 45 metres above the forest floor and offers spectacular views of the Illawarra and Wollongong region.

The Treetop Walk commences at the visitor's centre where you are subtly introduced to the rainforest. As you proceed along the level walkway the ground progressively drops away taking you on a journey through the upper reaches of the rainforest vegetation strata.

Emerge through the ferns of the forest floor to the tranquillity and beauty of the forest canopy.

This is a unique nature based experience that will have your senses tingling where you will see the trees and forest ecology in a new light.

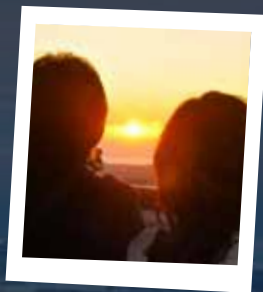

The sunrise tour takes advantage of the beautiful light the sun casts as it rises over the landscape and over the Tasman Sea – truly magical!
